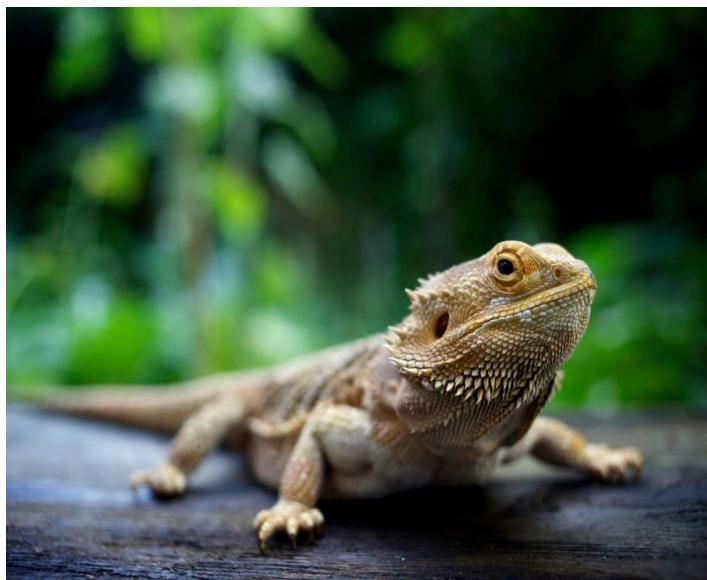
Species name: Pogona

Facts:

- If the bearded dragon lost its tail, it would not grow back because it does not regenerate like other lizards.
- Adults fully grown are 2 feet long. Females are usually smaller than males.
- Their colors change slightly to help regulate their temperature.
- They lose their front teeth when they try to bite their prey, but they grow back regularly. Their side teeth are permanent.
- Australia made it illegal to take bearded dragons
- Bearded dragons are omnivorous meaning they eat both animals and plants.
- The bearded dragon is diurnal meaning they are active during the day and sleep at night.
- When it gets scared it flattens out its body, puffs its throat, and opens its mouth to make it appear larger. This is how they got their name because it looks like a beard and since it flattens out and looks bigger, that's how it got the dragon part of its name.
